Heritage Foods commissions 2.1 MW wind power project in AP

Heritage Foods has commissioned the 1st Wind Power Plant of 2.1 MW Capacity at Survey No. 40/A2, Chinahothur Village, Vajrakarur Mandal, Ananthapur District, Andhra Pradesh on 27th March 2016 for captive consumption. This Plant is expected to generate 5 Million units per annum to be utilized/consumed at Gokul Dairy Plant and Chittoor Dairy Plant of the Company under Captive Open Access Arrangement through APTRANSCOM/APSPDCL.

It's S90-97 90 Meters Hub Height potential to generate more Elect Units than regular WEGs one of the Latest generation Technology available in Indian Wind Power Market.

The successful commissioning has largely been possible due to the unstinted efforts of M/s Suzlon Group Company. The professional approach helped achieve the plant to be commissioned within 90 days and connect to AP TRANSCO 33 KV Pooling Sub Station at Vajrakarur. The Plant will be maintained by M/s Suzlon Group Company for initial period of 10 years.
